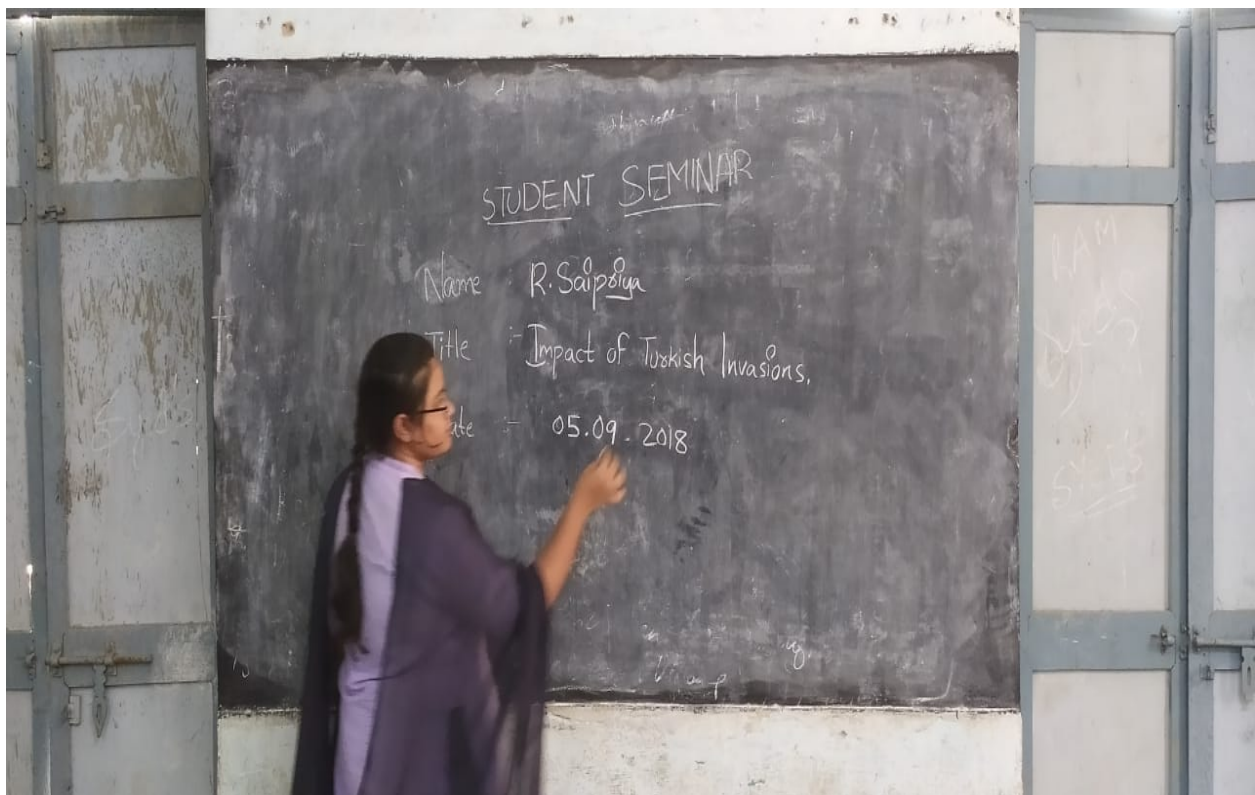
Important Rulers of Delhi Sultanate:
