In all, five competitions were held exclusively for 50 visually impaired students from Vijayawada and Guntur. The unique competitions like Fastest Fingers First enabled students to explore their typing capabilities on a laptop using NVDA software. In 'Guess the item' students need to identify the objects and grocery items using the two senses touch and smell. There were also competitions like speech on the given topic, singing and quiz.
